In 2019, 75.8% of scrap tires were consumed in end-use markets, making them one of the most recycled products in the United States.

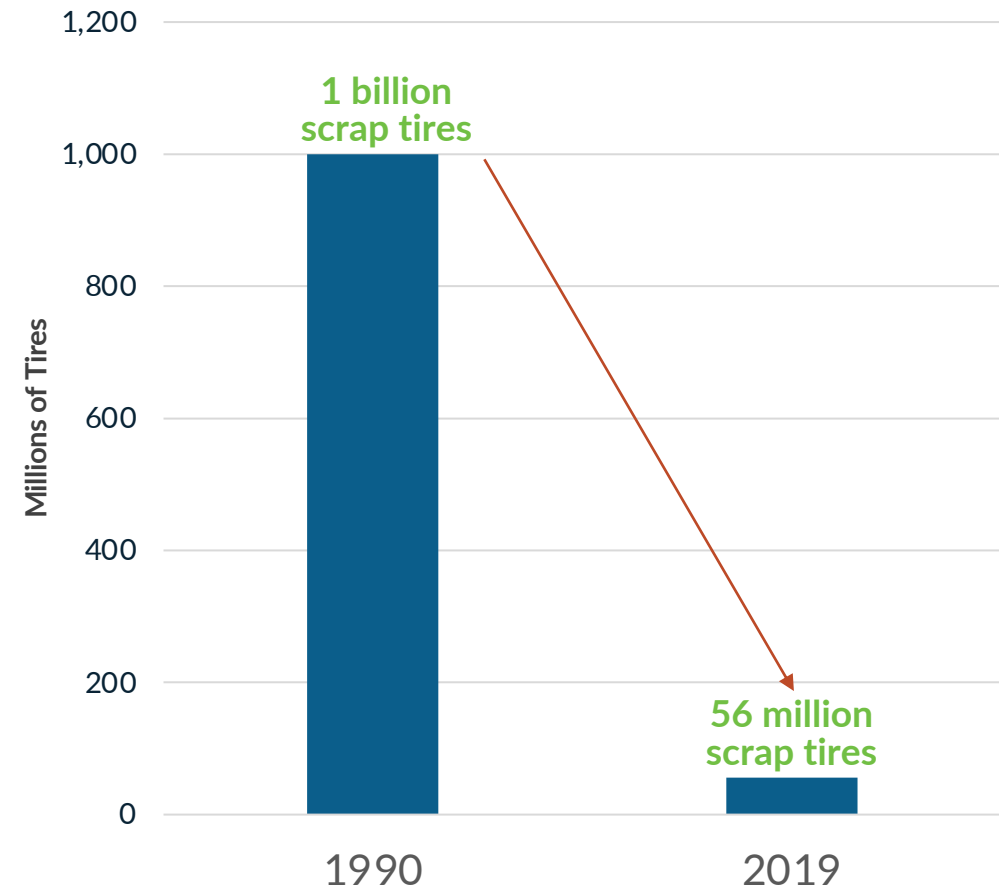

The U.S. saw a **94% drop** in scrap tire stockpiles from 1990 to 2019.

USTMA's work with state legislators and regulators, to develop abatement programs, played a significant role in the dramatic **reduction from 1 billion to 56 million tires.**
